Application for Membership in the American Association of Physical Anthropologists

Regular membership in the American Association of Physical Anthropologists is by election at the annual business meeting of the Association (usually held in March or April) after approval by the Membership and Credentials Committee. Thus all applicants are normally enrolled initially as special or student members and receive the American Journal of Physical Anthropology and the Yearbook of Physical Anthropology. Applications must be accompanied by full annual dues payment, which includes subscription. Payment must be in U.S. funds (see dues below) by check, MasterCard, or VISA. REGULAR MEMBERSHIP

is open to professional anthropologists, advanced students showing evidence of professional capacity, professionals in cognate sciences, and others who have demonstrated qualification by publication or professional activities. Only regular members are entitled to hold office and to vote for officers and on other issues in the Association.

STUDENT MEMBERSHIP

is open to bona fide students for a maximum of six years. Students applying for memberships must be certified by a professor familiar with their qualifications.

SPECIAL MEMBERSHIP

is open to students who have been members for 6 years and to non-students wishing to subsequently be considered for regular membership. Persons with a professional interest in physical anthropology currently not desiring or accepted for regular membership may also apply for, or continue, special membership.

RETIRED (EMERITUS/A) MEMBERSHIP

is available to regular members after 25 years in good standing who have retired. Retired members are relieved of payment of Association dues without impairment of standing but must continue to pay subscription costs to continue receiving Association publications.

SPOUSES

who are both members in any membership category are required to pay only one subscription for Association publications.
